Introduction

The Club's Facebook page was originally set up to act as a tool for easy communication between all members of the Club - Coaches, Committee Members, Parents and Swimmers. This is still its prime purpose, however the Committee would like to issue some guidance to ensure that it is not misused and members can continue to use this facility.

The FNSC page is a private page and is for the explicit use of members of the club and their parents/guardians. In accordance with Facebook's own conditions, swimming members under the age of 13 will not be granted membership of the group (their parent may join on their behalf).

The main uses will remain as:

- Communicating changes or cancellations to the normal weekly training schedule that need to be made at short notice.
- Reminders about forthcoming competitions, changes of venue, departure/warm up times and related topics.
- Items lost and found at training or competition.
- Advertising club activities such as social events, Annual General Meetings and similar.
- Posts relating to competitive results should be of a *general* nature, and great care must be taken prior to making a post which mentions an individual. This includes the posting of any photographs and those posting must ensure that the club's photographic policy is adhered to. If unsure about reports of this nature please refer to the Head Coach.

If an individual wishes to communicate with another member, then please use the private message facility.

Finally, we would ask all to consider how your post may impact upon other members of the club.
